Abstract submission guidelines

- Abstracts are limited to 2.000 characters (excluding title and author affiliations). The number of characters must be indicated
- The abstract title should not exceed 100 characters
- Abstract structure should be as follows: introduction, research question(s)/hypotheses, methods, results, discussion (headings are not required)
- Please allocate your abstract to one of the following categories:
 - Training
 - Physiology
 - Biomechanics
 - Coaching
 - Social
 - Medicine
 - Injuries
- Abstracts have to be presented as a poster and as short PowerPoint presentation (5 slides, 5 minute presentation + 2 minutes questions / discussion)
- A limited number of abstracts may be allocated as short presentations (10 minutes presentation + 5 minutes questions / discussion)
- The first author will be the presenting author, if the abstract is accepted
- A maximum of 9 co-authors from 5 different institutions can be listed on the abstract
- There is no limit for the number of abstracts that can be submitted per person, but note that short presentations have to be presented in person
- Please do not integrate any images or tables in the abstract text
- Congress language is English and all abstracts have to be submitted in English
- Abstracts will be reviewed by independent experts within the discipline
- Please register for the conference as soon as your abstract is accepted (<https://www.rudern.de/wcc2018>)
